Itinerary

Day 1 – Arrival in Reykjavík

Private transfer from Keflavík Airport to hotel
Stay: Sand Hotel, Reykjavík

Day 2 – Reykjavík Immersion

Explore the city on a private guided walk and enjoy a hands-on Icelandic cooking experience.
Stay: Sand Hotel, Reykjavík

Day 3 – Golden Circle Adventure

Depart Reykjavík with your guide, Jóhann. Visit Þingvellir National Park, the Geysir geothermal area, and Gullfoss waterfall.
Stay: Hotel Gullfoss

Day 4 – Highlands Exploration

Travel to Kerlingarfjöll for hiking and geothermal scenery. Relax in nature baths and enjoy a buffet dinner.
Stay: Hotel Highland

Day 5 – South Coast & Hidden Gems

Drive south via Réttir (if timing allows). Visit Seljalandsfoss, Gljúfrabúi, Nauthúsagil canyon, and Skógafoss.
Stay: Hotel Kría, Vík

Day 6 – Vík & Surroundings

Explore Dyrhólaey, Reynisfjara, and optional visits to a family farm, Lava Show, or hiking trails. Visit Yoda Cave before heading east.
Stay: Hótel Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon

Day 7 – Glacier Lagoon & Skaftafell

Enjoy a Zodiac boat tour at Jökulsárlón. Optional glacier walk or hike to Svartifoss and scenic viewpoints.
Stay: Glacier Lagoon area

Day 8 – Scenic East Coast Drive

Drive to Egilsstaðir via Djúpivogur and Petra's Stone Collection. Spot wild reindeer and visit the Reindeer Park.
Stay: Lake Hótel Egilsstaðir

Day 9 – Mývatn Geothermal Wonders

Visit Námaskarð hot springs, relax at Mývatn Nature Baths, and explore Hverfjall or Dimmuborgir.
Stay: Fosshotel Mývatn

Day 10 – Akureyri & Whale Watching

Drive to Akureyri via Goðafoss. Join a whale watching tour and visit Forest Lagoon Baths.
Stay: Hotel Kea, Akureyri

Day 11 – Journey to Snæfellsnes

Long scenic drive to Snæfellsnes Peninsula with stops en route.
Stay: Hótel Búðir

Day 12 – Snæfellsnes Peninsula Exploration

Full-day tour of the peninsula including Kirkjufell, Ólafsvík, Vatnshellir cave, and optional hikes near Búðir.
Stay: Hótel Búðir

Day 13 – Blue Lagoon Finale

Drive through Borgarnes and Hvalfjörður tunnel to the Blue Lagoon. Enjoy premium access before transferring to Keflavík.
Stay: Hotel Berg, Keflavík

Day 14 – Departure

Private transfer to the airport for your onward journey.
